GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

The city of Jerez is located in the south of Andalusia, surrounded by beautiful countryside and just a short drive from the Atlantic beaches and the Sierra mountains of the province of Cádiz.

It has the largest population in the province, with nearly 213,000 inhabitants, and is the second largest city in Andalusia in terms of extension.



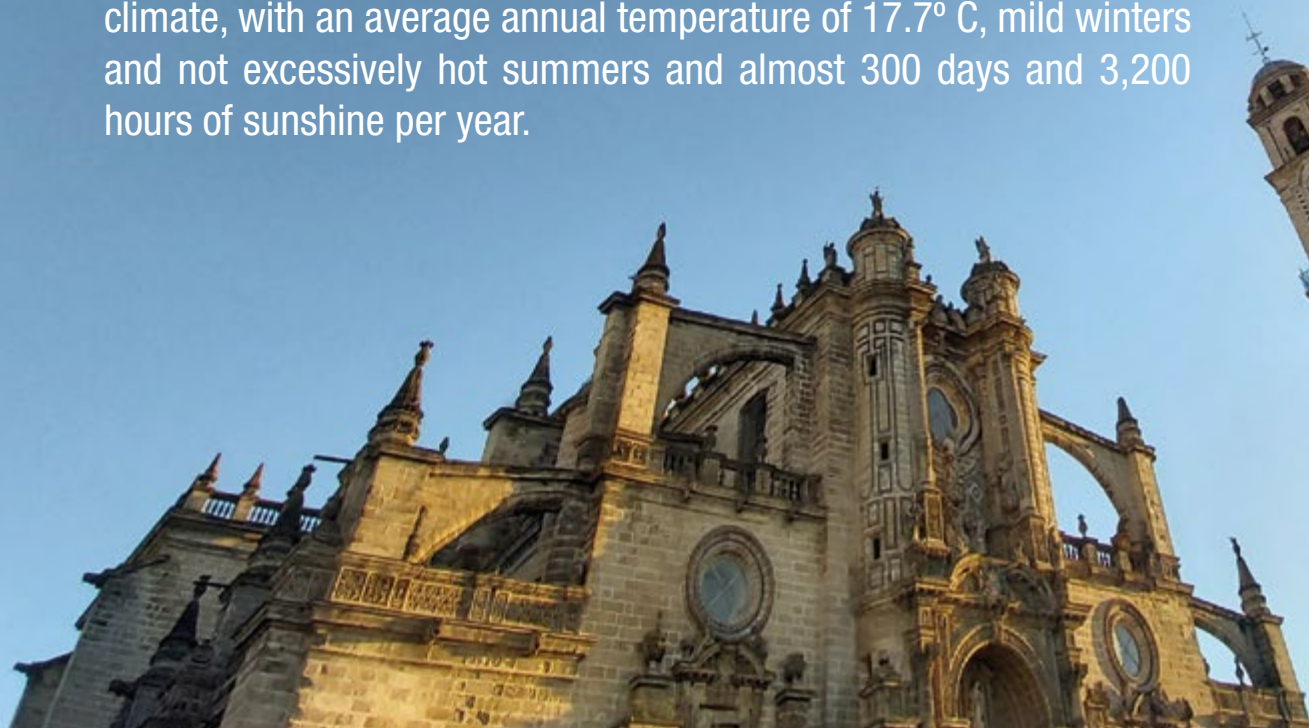
Jerez enjoys a privileged position and has excellent transport connections, making it an important communications link in the province of Cadiz.

Its exceptional location, between the mountains and the sea, and its good transport connections enable you to fully enjoy its diverse landscapes: coastal environments, countryside, mountains, white villages, fishing ports, pine forests, meadows, natural parks, marshes and lagoons. A whole range of interesting and unique experiences.

CLIMATE



Its proximity to the Atlantic Ocean means that Jerez enjoys a privileged climate, with an average annual temperature of 17.7° C, mild winters and not excessively hot summers and almost 300 days and 3,200 hours of sunshine per year.



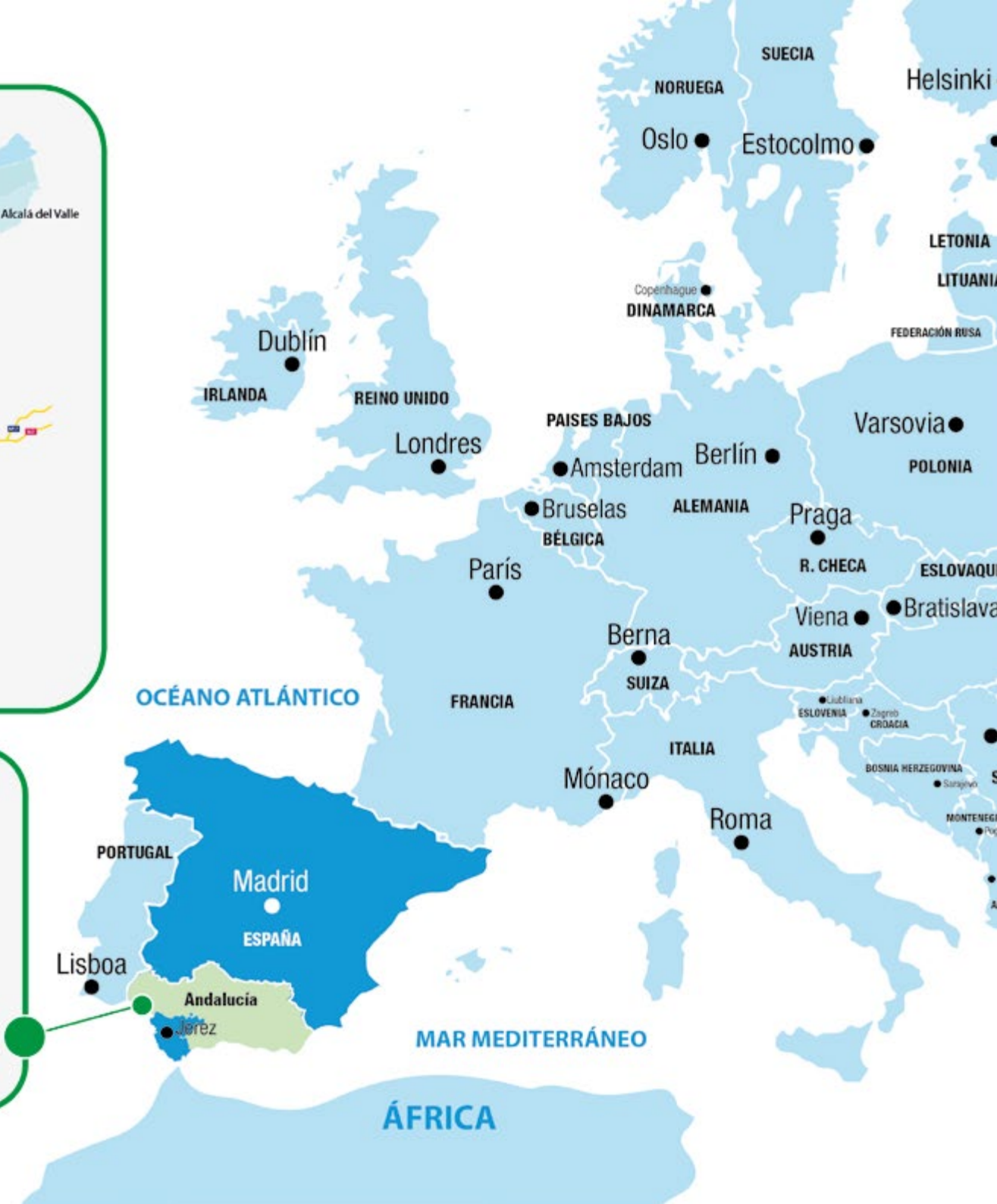
TRANSPORT CONNECTIONS

Jerez offers an excellent national and international transport network that facilitates access to the city and its region, as well as facilitating mobility throughout your stay.

Jerez Airport offers numerous flights to various Spanish and European capitals, located about 10 kilometres from the city centre and connected by train and bus to other cities in the province. The high-speed railway is another transport option, along with an excellent network of motorways and dual carriageways. The cruise ship terminal of Cádiz is only 20 minutes away.

Jerez is also within easy reach of another three airports of great affluence for tourism, those of Seville, Malaga and Gibraltar.

Jerez is the city of Sherry, Horses, Flamenco and Motor Racing. It also has a spectacular architectural heritage and its centre has been declared a Historic-Artistic Heritage Site. A visit to Jerez is a unique experience.





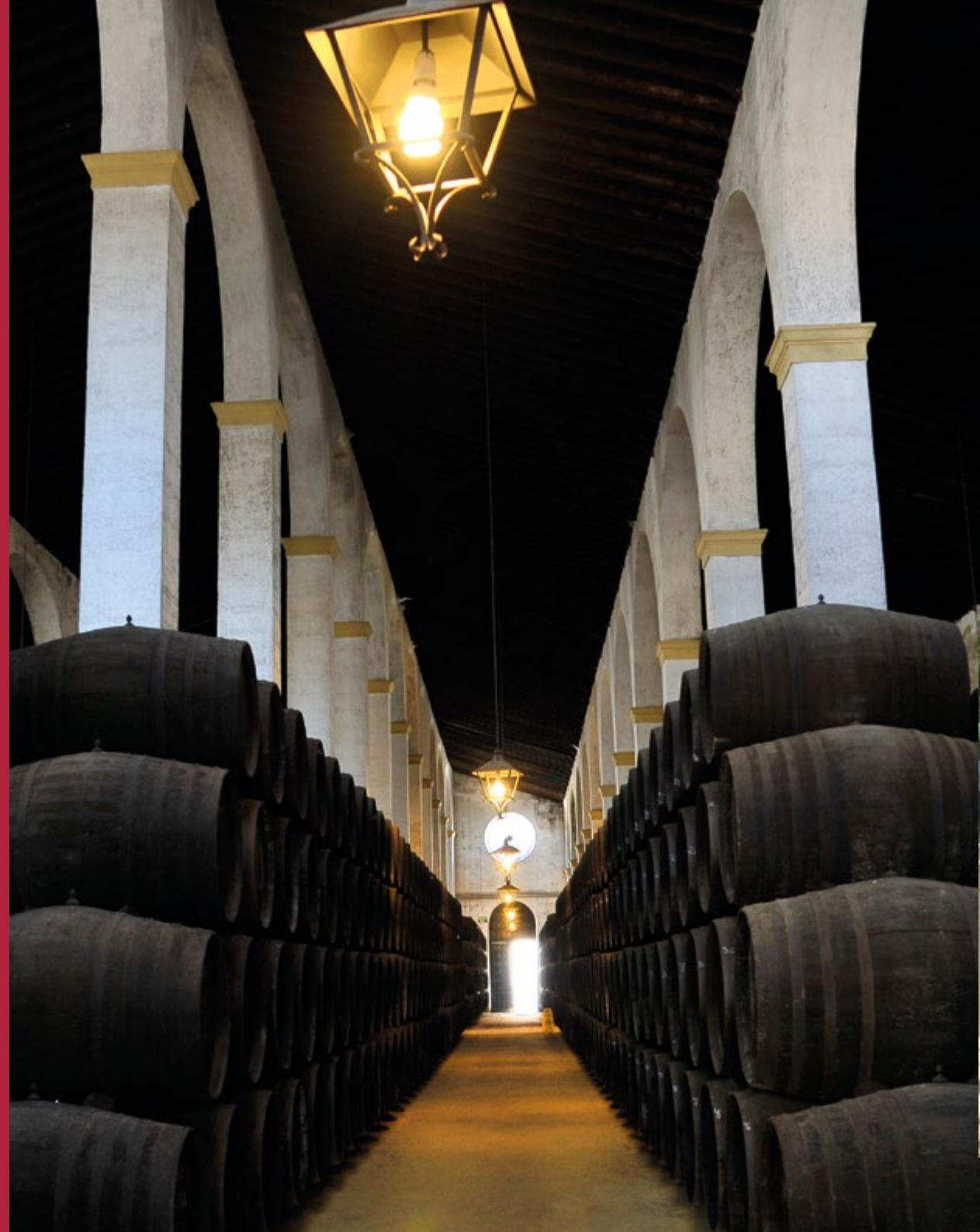
SHERRY

The albariza limestone soils, grape varieties and the unique “soleras and criaderas” system used for ageing wines in its bodegas, where sherry matures in silence, make the city a point of reference in the world of wine.

This is where the wines of Jerez, known around the world as Sherry, are produced.

There are many activities related to wine: guided bodega tours, commented tastings, visits to vineyards, food and wine pairings... The Grape Harvest Festival, held in September and declared of International Tourist Interest.

Vinoble, the International Fair for Fortified and Noble Wines held in May, and World Wine Tourism Day in November, are all major wine tourism events.



THE HORSE

Since the 15th century when, after a long process of equine genetic selection, the monks of the Carthusian monastery in Jerez created the breed of the Spanish Carthusian horse, the city has been renowned throughout the world for its beautiful horses.

Equestrian shows at the Royal Andalusian School of the Equestrian Art and the Yeguada de la Cartuja - Hierro del Bocado, major international equestrian events such as the Horse Fair, declared of International Tourist Interest, equestrian exhibitions during the Grape Harvest Festival, or the European Day of the Horse, all provide visitors with the opportunity to enjoy the horse throughout the year, making Jerez a city with an enormous variety of resources and activities related to the equestrian world. And for this reason, it offers the opportunity to enjoy an endless choice of possibilities related to this noble animal on a daily basis.



FLAMENCO

Flamenco has been declared an Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO.

Jerez is a universal reference point for Flamenco, being the city that has produced the most and best singers, dancers and guitarists throughout history.

Jerez offers flamenco shows on a daily basis in its famous tablaos, tabancos and peñas, as well as organizing important events and programmes such as the International Festival of Jerez, Flamenco Fridays in the summer months, the Fiesta de la Bulería and the famous Zambombas Flamencas at Christmas time.

Visits to the flamenco quarters of the city, the Andalusian Flamenco Centre, peñas, tabancos and tablaos make it possible to enjoy Flamenco and encounter unique experiences.



HERITAGE

The beautiful historic centre of Jerez has been declared a Historic and Artistic Monumental Site. We can contemplate its 12th century city walls, the Alcázar fortress with its small mosque, and visit the cathedral, old churches and mansion houses. The city has accessible spaces that facilitate mobility and numerous pedestrian areas that invite you to wander around, to stroll along the streets and enjoy some shopping, or taste our exquisite and varied local cuisine.



MOTOR RACING

The International Motorcycling Federation awarded Jerez the title of World Motorcycling City. The Angel Nieto Jerez Circuit, inaugurated in 1985, is one of the most famous racing circuits in Europe where competitions and training sessions are held for Formula One, Motor GP, Superbikes, Sport Prototypes and World Championships. The Jerez Circuit is also an ideal venue for holding MICE events.



GOLF

Jerez has two extraordinary golf courses just a few minutes from the centre: Montecastillo Barceló Golf Resort and Sherry Golf Jerez. Montecastillo Golf Resort is an 18-hole par 72 course designed by Jack Nicklaus and also has a Golf Academy as well as five and four star hotel accommodation, with meeting rooms for MICE events.

Sherry Golf Jerez is an 18-hole par 72 course designed by Stirling & Martin (Global Golf Company) and a 9-hole par 3. It has a Golf Academy.

There are also around 20 golf courses in the area surrounding Jerez.



SPORT AND ACTIVE TOURISM

The name Jerez is internationally associated with its Racing Circuit, where national and international competitions are held throughout the year, including the Spanish Motorcycle Grand Prix. Enthusiasts can also tour the Racing Circuit and Motor Museum.



Jerez has state-of-the-art sports facilities, such as the Chapín Sports Complex where numerous different sports can be practised.

The Barceló Montecastillo Golf Resort is home to the High Performance Sports Centre, ideal for training football and elite sports teams. Equestrian activities, athletics, golf, trekking, motor sports, and more than 40 kilometres of cycle paths along the main thoroughfares of the city, make Jerez the ideal place for enthusiasts of sport and nature.



NATURE

Jerez is one of the most extensive, most diverse and richest municipal areas in Andalusia.

Rural Jerez encompasses large areas of countryside, where wheat and sunflowers alternate with vineyards, the cultivated fertile lowlands of the river Guadalete and the mountains of the Los Alcornocales Nature Park, all of which are dotted with numerous rural towns and villages.

This heterogeneous environment offers a wealth of culture, heritage, history, gastronomy, monuments and landscapes, where you can enjoy numerous activities, especially those related to nature and active sports.

A wide range of local companies organize activities in the natural environment, such as vineyard tours, a visit to the Bee and Honey Museum, walks through the Alcornocales Natural Park or a Yoga workshop in the vineyards.



GASTRONOMY

Jerez has an exquisite and varied gastronomy. High quality local produce: fresh vegetables from the surrounding countryside, fish and seafood from the nearby Atlantic Ocean, meats from the Sierra mountains and the surrounding area, together with that distinctive touch from renowned chefs who contribute their creativity and knowledge to produce exquisite dishes.



Sherry and Brandy de Jerez combine in this gastronomic mix, either as ingredients in a dish or as the perfect pairing. Restaurants, bars and tabancos in Jerez offer an eno-gastronomic experience that includes both traditional and avant-garde dishes, some with the recognition of Michelin Stars and Repsol Suns.



SHOPPING AND LEISURE

Jerez has a wide range of shopping and dining options in its historic centre, which combines traditional shops, craft shops, leading brands and its unique Central Food Market with fresh produce from the sea and the market garden.



Likewise, the outskirts of the city offer one of the most complete and attractive shopping centres in Andalusia, with a whole range of options for shopping and restaurant enthusiasts.



CULTURAL ACTIVITY



Jerez offers an extensive and vibrant cultural programme of classical and contemporary performing arts and an enormous historical and artistic heritage. Talent and creativity nurture a cultural atmosphere that has positioned the city as a candidate for the European Capital of Culture in 2031.

Exhibition halls, museums, craft markets, open-air art, a thousand options to surprise the visitor at any time of the year.

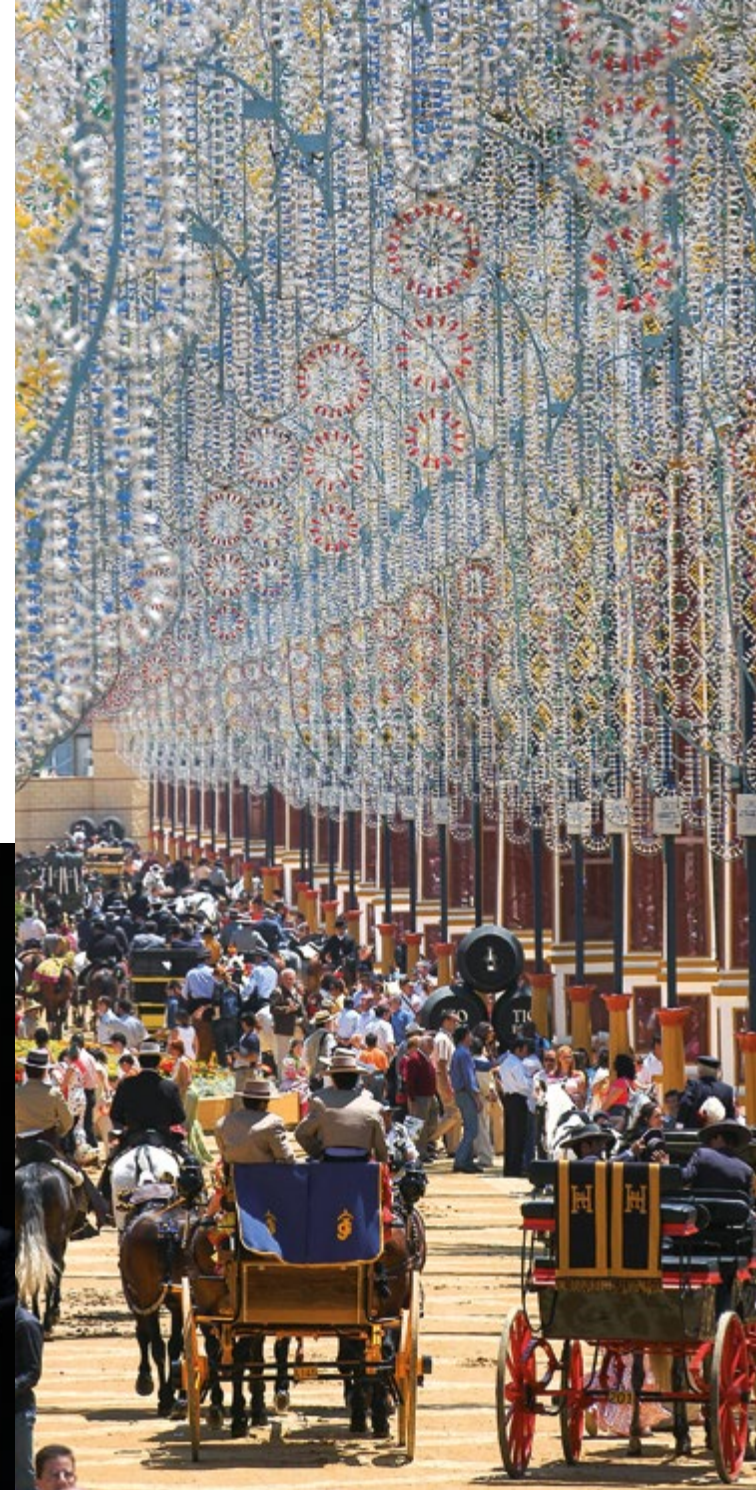

CALENDAR OF FESTIVALS AND EVENTS

Jerez offers a spectacular calendar of events that means you can enjoy a visit to the city at any time of year. The Jerez International Flamenco Festival between the months of February and March; the Carnival in the month of February; the spectacular Semana Santa in March or April, declared of National Tourist Interest; the World Motorcycle Championship held in the month of April or May; the Horse Fair, declared of International Tourist Interest, which takes place every year in May. Followed by a very comprehensive summer of activities and events linked to music and especially to Flamenco, such as the Fiesta de la Bulería, Noches de Bohemia and Flamenco Fridays during the months of July and August, or the Fiestas de la Vendimia, declared of International Tourist Interest, in September, these being some of the most outstanding events held throughout the year.





To these we have to add the celebration of the European Day of the Horse, in September; in November, Wine Tourism Week and Andalusian Flamenco Day and the famous Zambombas de Jerez at Christmas time, during the month of December, each of these a very relevant proposal on the festive calendar of Jerez. Similarly, numerous festive cycles of classical music, flamenco, opera, theatre, exhibitions, conferences, competitions and equestrian shows, automobile and motorcycle racing at the Jerez Racing Circuit; the Vinoble International Salon of Noble and Fortified Wines, the Tío Pepe Festival, the Copa Jerez international competition of gastronomic harmonies with Sherry, the “de Copa en Copa” Sherry fair and Masterclass Tastings, among other proposals, make it possible for Jerez to provide a range of cultural and leisure options.

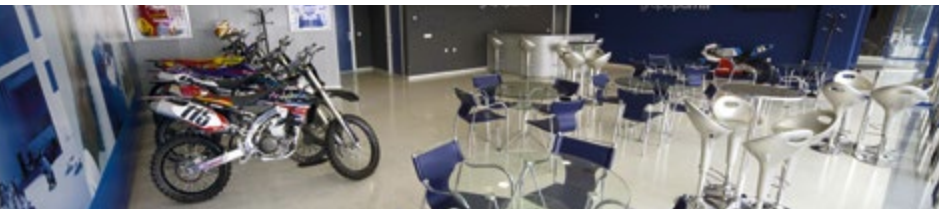

The Domecq Palace is the finest example of Baroque architecture in Jerez in the 18th century.

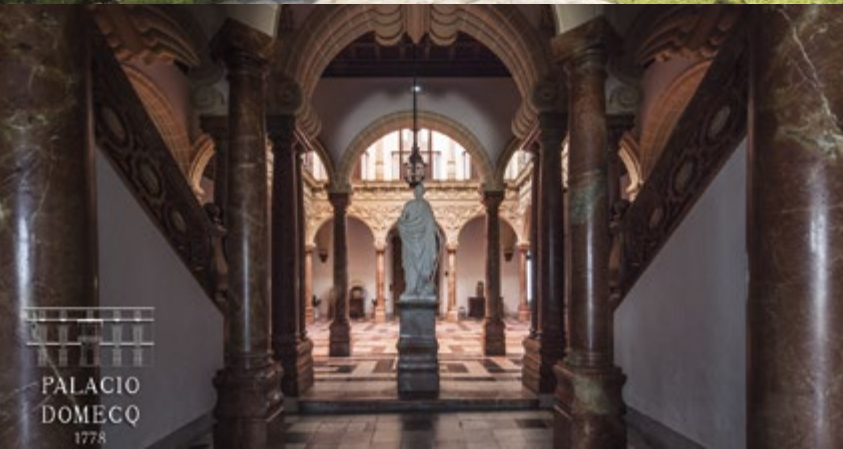
One of the families with the longest winemaking tradition in the city lived in this palace.
